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E. Content - "Role of Gender for Socialization in reference to law and role of State"

Gender role socialization begins at birth and continues throughout the life course. Our society is quick to outfit male infants in blue and girls in pink, even applying these colour-coded gender labels while a baby is in the womb. Thus, gender like race is a social construction with very real consequences. The drive to adhere to masculine and feminine gender roles continues later in life. Children learn at a young age that there are distinct expectations for boys and girls. Cross culture studies reveal that children are aware of gender roles by age - two or three. Like adults, children become agents who actively facilitate and apply normative gender expectations to those around them. Gender socialization occurs through four major agents of socialization -
